## ARTISTS IN RESIDENCE MATT WOODHAM & BENJAMIN SHIRLEY-QUIRK



Matt Woodham and Benjamin Shirley-Quirk were selected for one of three Collaborative Project Bursaries, in partnership with NMG Development Programme, aimed at pairs looking to work together collaboratively to develop and deliver projects. The group will research and develop the mechanical, electronic and programmatic systems to illuminate obfuscated truths. Experimenting with the semantic interpretation of symbolic and pictographic historical languages, and the interaction of light, motion and meaning to create a knowledge system that proclaims to provide answers.

Melitta Nemeth will co-curate and feature alongside two women artists selected by open call. ## GALLERY RE-OPENING

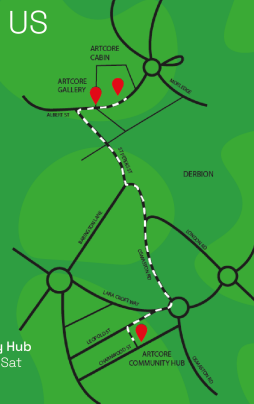
